Taxi: To the Veterinary Science Conference Centre costs approximately \$30

Train: The Airport Link train to Central station costs approximately \$15 (one way). From Central station, you can head to the venue by either taxi or bus (as below).

From Central Station

Taxi : To the Veterinary Science Conference Centre costs approximately \$15.

Bus : From George Street or Railway Square at Sydney's Central Station there are a number of buses that you can take that will stop at the Ross Street Gate of the University. These are bus routes 412, 413, 435, 436, 437, 438, 440, 461, and 480. From the Ross Street Gate, the Veterinary Science Conference Centre is a 2 minute walk.

Public transport in NSW is now cashless. You can use your debit or credit card to tap on when travelling on trains, buses and the light rail. Opal travel cards are also available to purchase, for more information and a list of retailers visit <https://transportnsw.info/>

Parking

With limited parking on campus, we encourage you to use public transport, walk or cycle. Cars parked on campus without a parking ticket will incur fines by City of Sydney parking rangers.

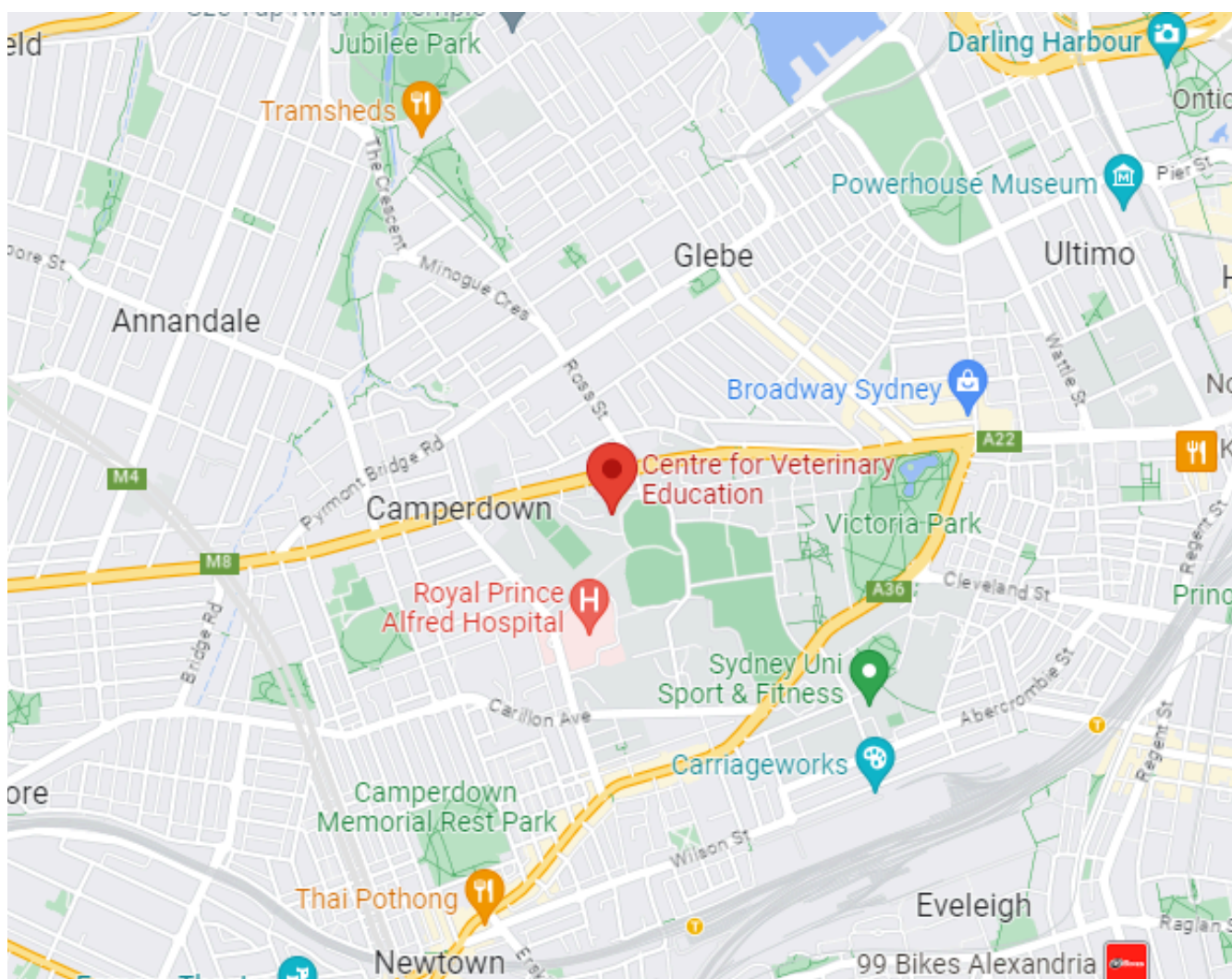
The parking meters are “Pay by Plate”. Park your vehicle, go to the meter, pay the fee, enter your vehicle’s registration number and go on your way.

You can also pay with credit card using the free mobile App, CellOPark.
