The importance of both short- and long-term radiographic monitoring, alongside visual and tactile assessment of the restoration, will be emphasized, ensuring you're prepared for all aspects of post-operative care.

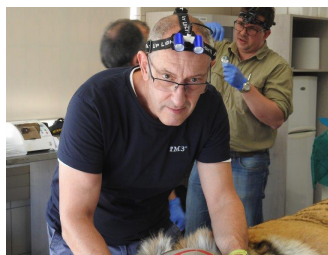
